What's posing threats to honeybee?

Bees among other insect pollinators are considered the key contributor that provides insect pollination service for more than 87% of flowering plant species. Bee populations, however, are declining globally, increasing public awareness and research activity in the field of pollination ecology. There has been a great advancement in researches on this declining trend due to global changes including climate change and environmental destruction, and their causal effects for pollination service. However, those factors are not emerging stressors but have existed since industrialization began. Here, we need a new perspective on what are the unknown environmental stressors that bees are vulnerable to.
